Gallery Jones is pleased to announce the September exhibition of work by Vancouver artist Anselmo Swan.

Swan's personal affinity for the works of the Dutch masters has led him to an approach to still life painting that is grounded in quiet contemplation. The disposable, consumable and ubiquitous objects he chooses to depict become symbols through the sheer skill and attention he has employed in rendering them. These symbols comment on our contemporary life in subtle and humorous ways and take on an existence beyond that of an ordinary ice cream sandwich or hot cup of coffee.

This is Swan's second exhibition with Gallery Jones and his first solo exhibition. Swan, who was born in Vancouver, graduated from the Emily Carr Institute of Art and Design, and currently lives and works here. His work has been exhibited in Vancouver, Toronto, London (UK) and Los Angeles.
